ORDER SCHEDULING FURTHER BAIL HEARING



NOTICE OF HEARING - CRIMINAL

The above entitled case has been scheduled for the following:
Date: 11/28/2001 Time: 2:30 pm Room: Courtroom 1
For: further bail hearing Violation of the Terms of Probation or Parole

If you are charged with a motor vehicle violation, other than DWI, and are unable to appear or wish to change your plea to guilty or no contest, you must notify the court in writing at least ten (10) days prior to the above date. You should send a copy of your notification to the prosecutor. The court will inform you of the proper procedure.

When a person pleads guilty or is convicted after trial the court will require all fines imposed to be paid in full immediately.

Please advise clients, witnesses, and others that it is a class B felony to carry a firearm or other deadly weapon as defined in RSA 625:11,V in a courtroom or area used by a court.

FAILURE TO APPEAR OR PROPERLY OBTAIN A CONTINUANCE
BY THE COURT MAY RESULT IN AN ORDER FOR YOUR ARREST.

RSA 599-1-c: Any person charged with any violation may, at least 5 (five) days prior to trial, request the district or municipal court that a sound recording be kept of all proceedings in the trial. If such a request is made, the district or municipal court shall make the sound recording at no cost to the person requesting it.

RSA 502 A:27-d: If you are charged with a Class B misdemeanor you are entitled to a sound recording of the proceedings at the state's expense. You must make a written request to the clerk for a sound recording at least five days prior to any hearing.
